<b>Course: SK.Theo-EIRENE.04.Pr Self-organised ecumenical internship</b> Usually, the internship (at least 120 hours) takes place in a church community or a school that is characterized by a high proportion of international members; alternative internship locations have to be approved by the person responsible for the module. During the internship, students must autonomously organize an intercultural meeting with members of the relevant institution.
